INFORMATION FOR CAMPGROUND SUPERVISOR (PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS, LOCATION PREFERENCES, ETC.)

1. No Electrical Hook-up are available for the campground, including access to electrical in the barns.
2. Generators may be used between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. only.
3. Please observe all camping rules listed on the Fair Complex website and any posted regulations.
4. No parking of motorized vehicles, except motor homes and truck campers, are allowed inside the campground.
5. Upon arrival at the campground, check in with the campground supervisor and pick-up your site assignment.
6. All campers under 18 must be staying with an adult chaperone, at least 21 years of age.
7. All chaperones are required to stay over-night in the campsite and must sign below as the chaperone of the persons listed above.

Livestock Exhibitor Campground

We ask that you observe the following:

- Only registered Animal Exhibitors with 4H, FFA and Open Class may stay or visit the Livestock Exhibitor Campground.
- The Campground Supervisor assigns the sites and all camping will be in designated sites only.
- All youth exhibitors camping are required to have an adult, camping at the assigned site, who will assume responsibility for the youth's conduct and health.
- There is a maximum of eight campers per site.
- No person shall consume, or have in his or her possession, any controlled substance or alcoholic beverage (if under age) as described in ORS 471.005.
- Motor vehicles are not allowed in the camping area. Except for move in/move out purposes.
- No animals or pets allowed in the camping area by order of Health Dept.
- All campers are required to be in their camping unit and quiet one-half hour (11:30 p.m.) after the fair closes (11 p.m.)
- All campers are to abide by posted camping regulations. Persons not following these guidelines may be asked to leave the camping area.
- The Fair Management does not assume responsibility for the health and safety of persons camping; however, will endeavor to provide a safe and healthy atmosphere.
